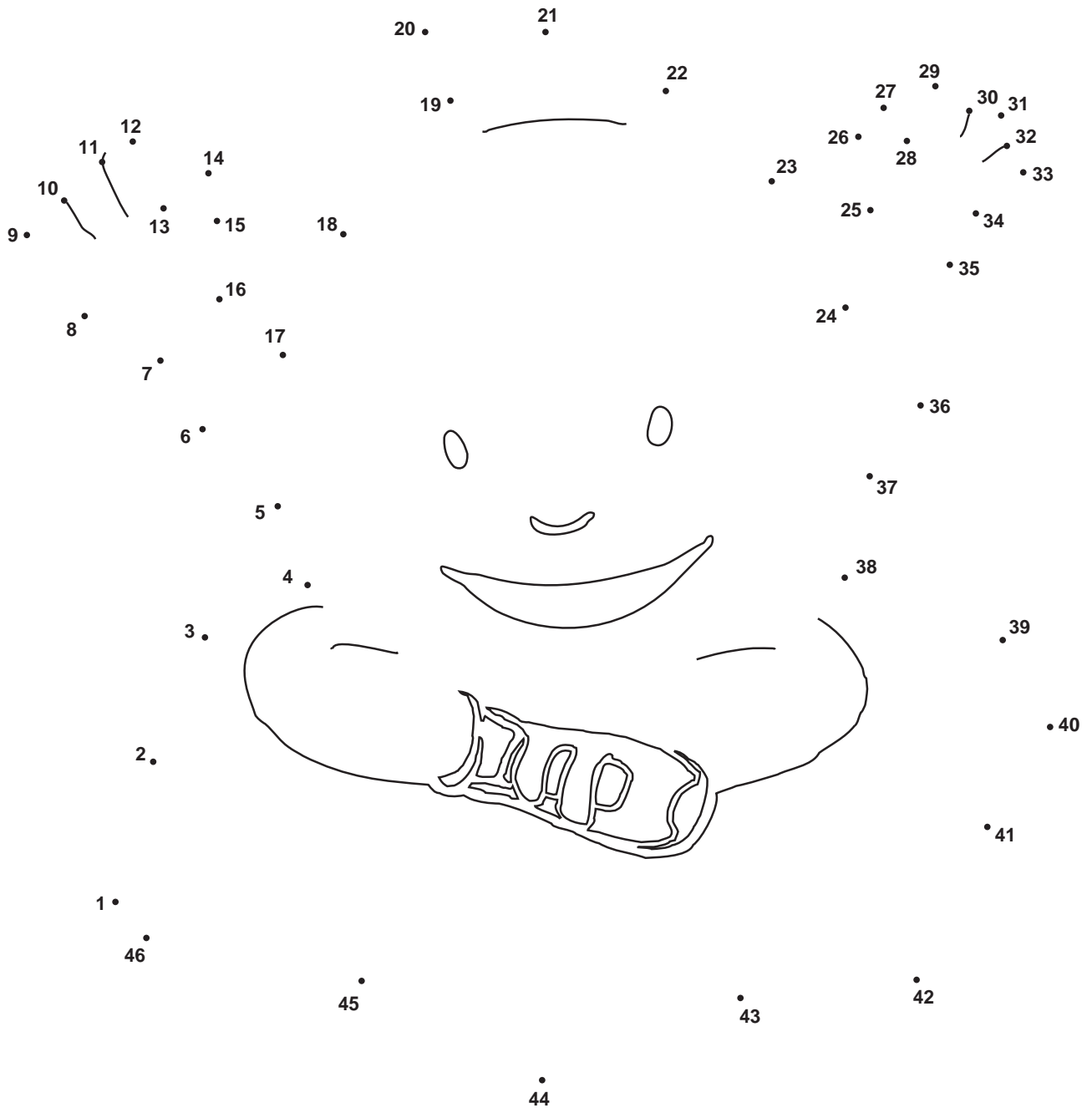

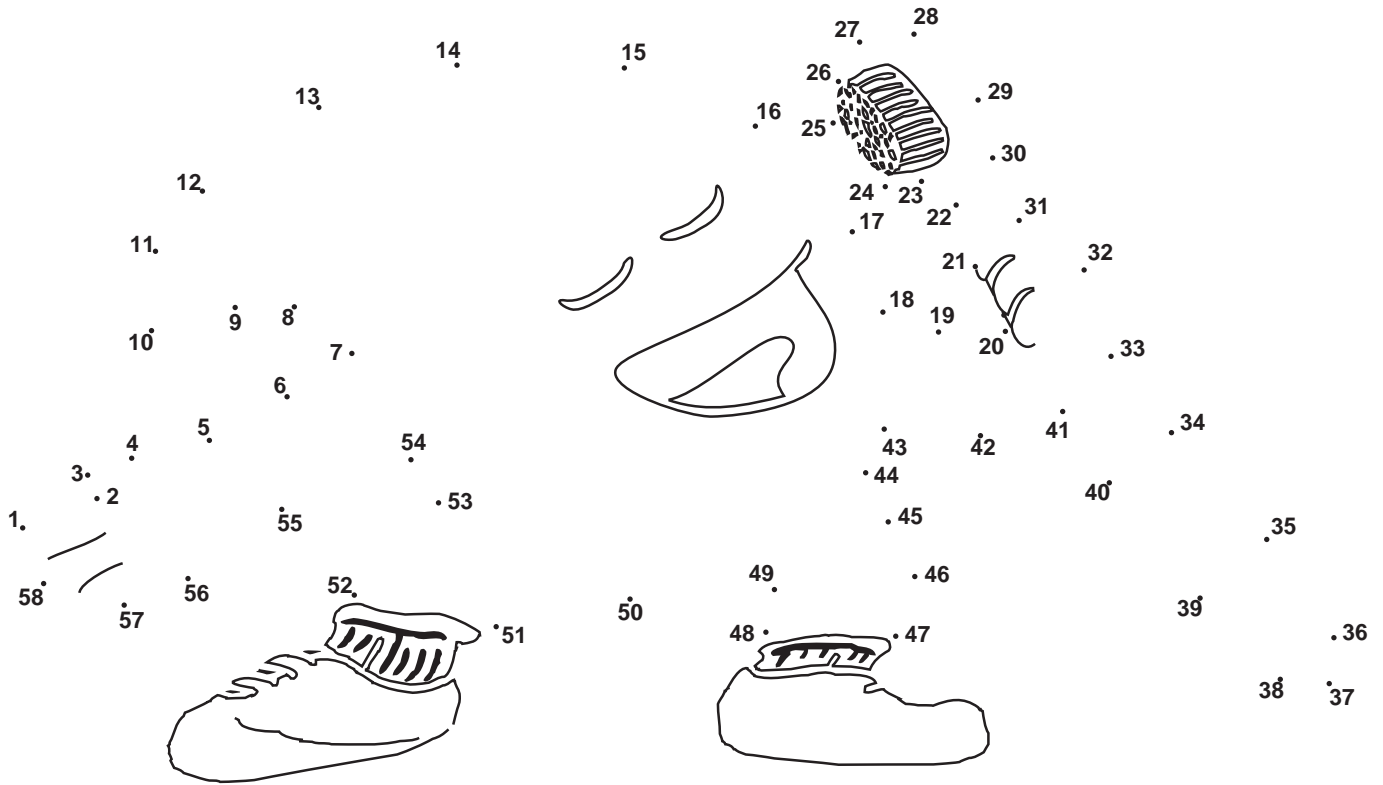

# Make your own Waterwise badge



## **Badge making instructions**

1. Colour your badge
2. With the help of an adult, cut around the outside of the circle
3. Punch hole in the top centre of the badge
4. Attach with safety pin

## **Laminated badge**

1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 from above
2. Place badge in laminating pouch
3. Feed through laminator
4. Cut around the outside of the circle leaving 5mm gap
5. Punch hole in the top centre of the badge
6. Attach with safety pin

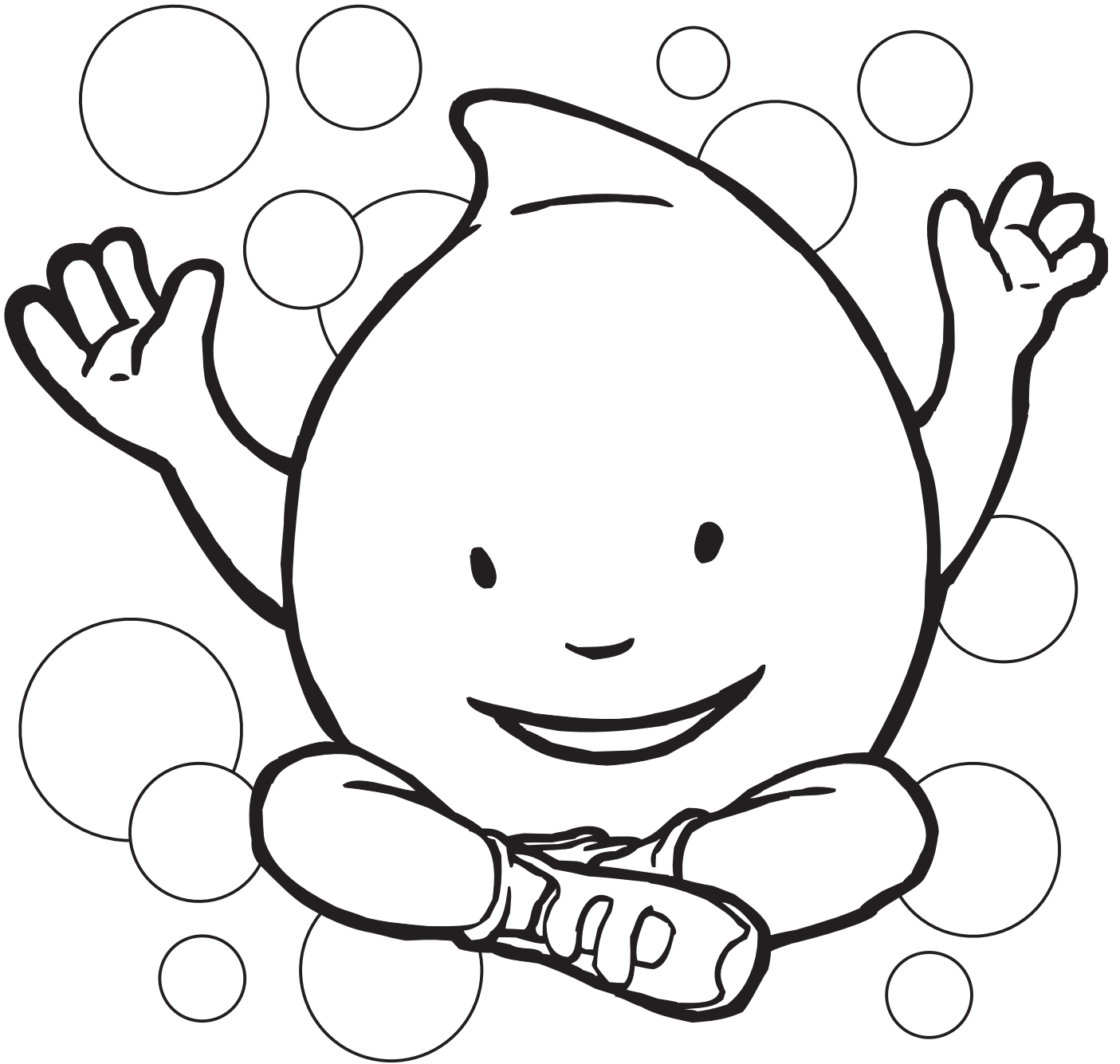


## **Badge making instructions**

1. Colour your badge
2. With the help of an adult, cut around the outside of the circle
3. Punch hole in the top centre of the badge

## **Laminated badge**

1. Repeat steps 1 and 2 from above

3. Feed through laminator
4. Cut around the outside of the circle leaving 5mm gap
5. Punch hole in the top centre of the badge
6. Attach with safety pin

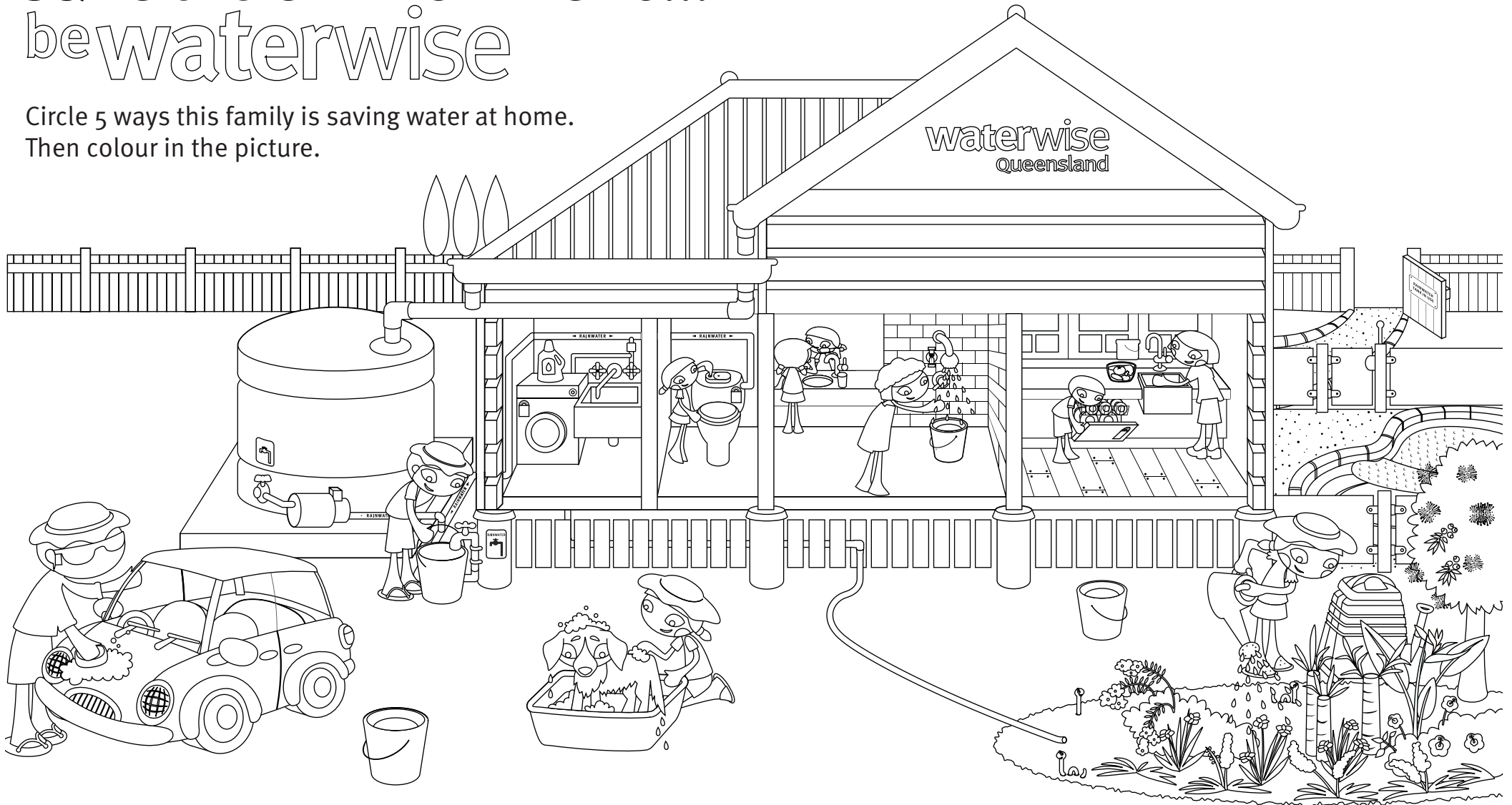

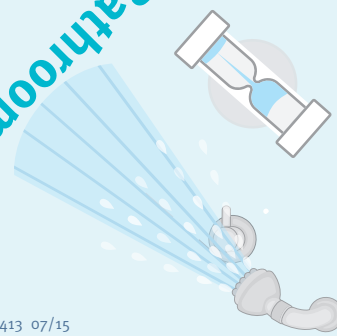

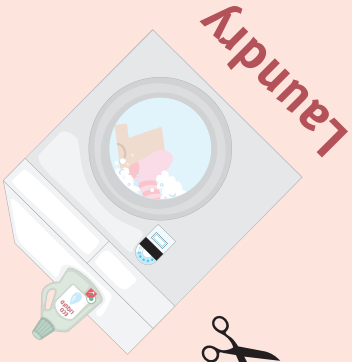

**Water is a precious resource that needs to be conserved now and in the future. Being water efficient is easy. Make a difference today!**

### How to make your chatterbox

- Cut along black dotted line to remove chatterbox from page.
- Place face down and fold outer corners into the centre of the chatterbox so you are left with a square shape.
- Turn over so that the answers are facing up.
- Fold each tip into the centre so that you are left with a square shape with the questions facing up.
- Turn over so that the pictures are facing up.
- Fold in half vertically to create a crease.
- Open back up to the square shape.
- Fold in half horizontally to create a crease.
- Use your thumbs and forefingers to form a peak underneath the pictures.
- Now you are ready to play!
- Use your fingers to shift the game in and out to expose the inside panels.
- Now pick a picture or word from one of the corners. As you spell out the name of the picture/word, move the chatterbox in and out.
- Pick a question from the inside of the game. Open to find out if you answered correctly.
