Clean up your yard in October



Make your yard safe in preparation for storm season

Council's waste facilities offer **FREE** disposal of specific waste types all year round. During the month of October we encourage residents to get ready for storm season by cleaning up your yard and getting rid of anything that could be dangerous in a storm.

Sort your load before you come in. Pack rubbish on the bottom and recycling on the top to avoid unnecessary charges.

Offer applies to **domestic and household loads only**. Commercial loads will be charged at normal rates.

ITEMS ACCEPTED THAT MAY POSE A RISK IN A STORM - NO CHARGE*

Metal or clean untreated timber outdoor play equipment (trampolines, swings, etc)	✓
Clean untreated timber items such as small animal enclosures or dog kennels (dismantled)	✓
Outdoor furniture in reusable condition (tables, chairs, pool & deck lounges)	✓
Metal barbeques	✓
Clean untreated timber or metal fencing materials	✓
Dismantled outdoor structures* (metal or timber garden sheds, gazebos, etc) *excludes concrete	✓
Gardening equipment (pots, shovels, rakes etc) in reusable condition	✓
Empty compost bins / worm farms in reusable condition	✓

*Acceptance of items at no charge is at the discretion of the gatehouse operator
