

Road Reconstruction and Widening — River Road (Chainage 1096 to 1581)

PROJECT:

This project provides for pavement reconstruction and widening of a 485m section of River Road, Tinana between Chainage 1096 and 1581.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's gravel road sealing prioritisation process.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$400,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The Project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Pavement reconstruction;
- Kerb and channel construction;
- Subsoil drainage works;
- Bitumen sealing;
- Longitudinal and transverse drainage;
- Signage and restoration works.

The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period proposes to undertake the works under a full road closure.



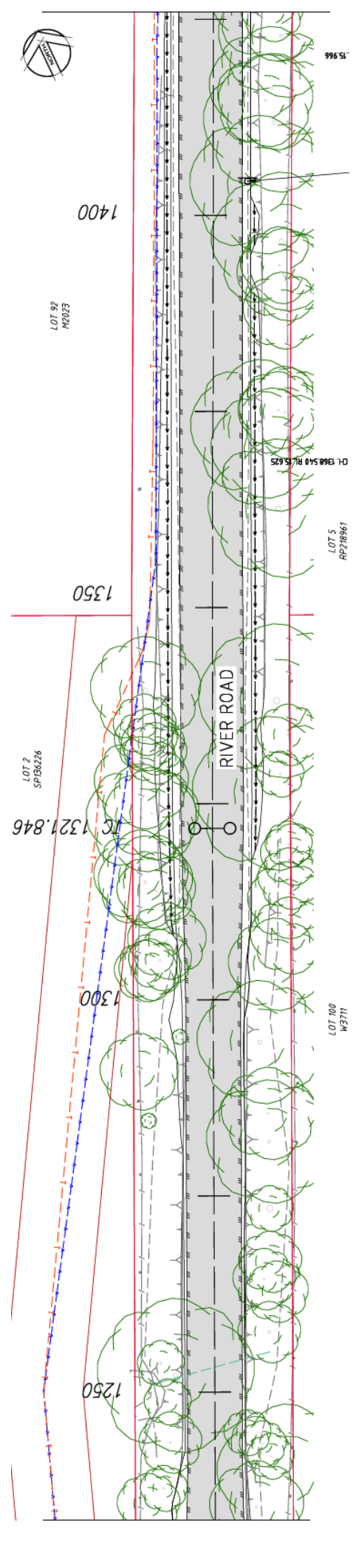
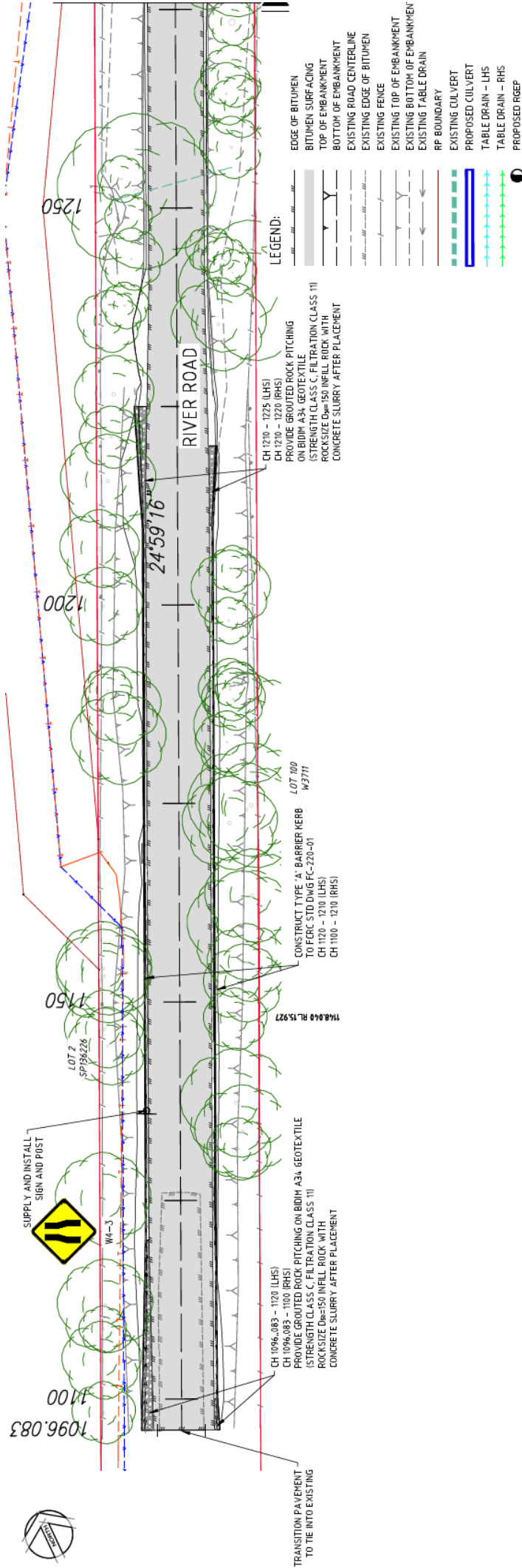
INDICATIVE PROJECT MILESTONES
