Benarige Creek, St Mary’s Road, Tiaro—Bridge Replacement

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of the St Mary’s Bridge located over Benarige Creek, St Mary’s Road, Tiaro. The works will provide for improved flood immunity at the bridge location and will also increase the bridge’s load limit from 35T to 60T.

The bridge replacement works are being undertaken as the result of a bridge inspection program that identified that the existing bridge required replacement as it had reached the end of its useful life.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1.26M (this project received funding from the Australian Government and is partly funded by Fraser Coast Regional Council)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS

The Project scope is as follows:

- Concrete bridge construction
- Concrete batters
- Concrete roadway
- Rock protection
- Table drain works
- Reshaping of existing gravel to suit new formation
- Signage



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will allow for a detour through Harris Extension Road. (see attached detour map)

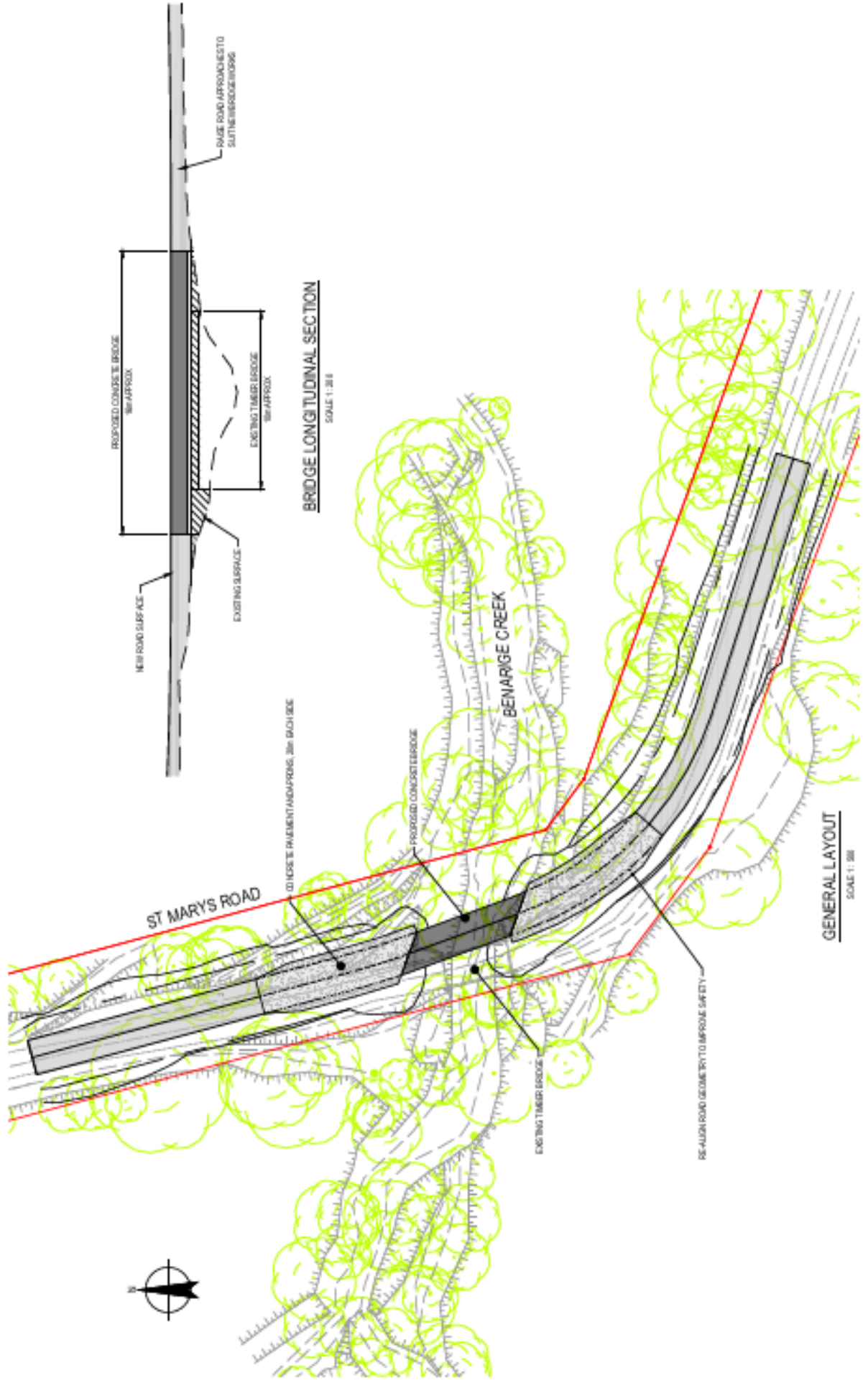
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
