Upgrade of Rail Trail (Elizabeth Street to Hunter Street, Hervey Bay)

PROJECT:

This project provides for an upgrade to the shared pathway along the Rail Trail between Elizabeth Street and Hunter Street, Hervey Bay. The works will include the replacement of the concrete footpaths that adjoin this section of the rail trail, renewal of the pavement and an upgrade to the lighting (between Bideford and Hunter Streets).

The upgrading works are being undertaken as a result of inspections carried out as part of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the pathway was showing signs of pavement failure and distress with the existing lighting system deteriorated and beyond repair. The lighting upgrade will also bring the lighting up to current standards.

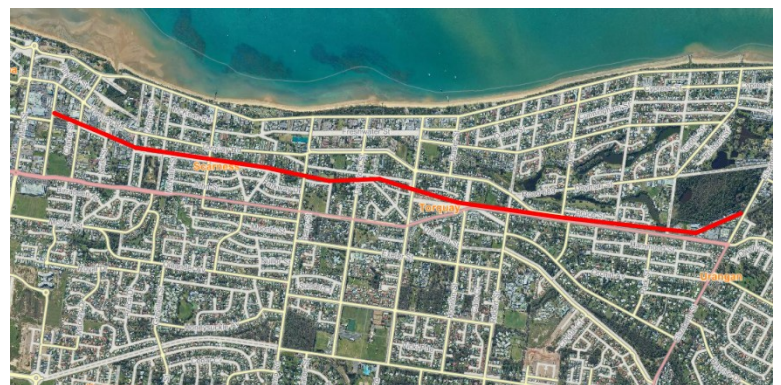
PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1M (this project is funded through the State Government's Covid Works for Queensland Funding Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The Project scope is as follows:

- Sectional footpath replacement works;
- Milling, sealing and asphalt works;
- Removal and disposal of all existing lights, poles foundations and cables and installation of new poles and fittings ;
- Top dressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
