

FAQ1: What does the mapping show and how has it been prepared?
 The mapping shows areas potentially vulnerable to coastal erosion for the present (2019 to 2030), 2050 and 2100 climates. The mapping is based on modelling assessments of erosion and sea level rise. The assessments follow the state government guidelines for determining coastal hazard areas.



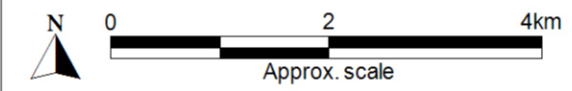
