Raised Priority Crossing—Beach Road and Watson Street

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a concrete raised priority crossing at the Beach Road/Watson Street intersection at Pialba. The works also include the replacement of the existing paved footpath with a 2.5m wide concrete shared path along Beach Road from Watson Street to the Esplanade.

The completion of these works will improve safety for cyclists and pedestrians.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$437,000 (This project is partly funded through the Queensland Government’s Cycle Network Local Government Grants program.)



The Contractors program will provide detail of traffic management for the duration of the construction period and/or detail traffic management arrangements including detours available.

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- General Earthworks;
- Kerb & Channel & 2xKerb Ramps;
- Blister Islands & Raised Platform;
- 4xresidential driveways (reinstatement works to be completed in plain concrete only);
- 160m x 2.5m concrete shared path;
- Stormwater inlet pits and grated drains;
- Linemarking and signage.
