

## Road and Drainage Works —

### Honiton St, Torquay (Torquay Terrace to Links Corridor)

#### PROJECT:

This project provides for road reconstruction and stormwater drainage works in Honiton Street Torquay between Torquay Terrace and the Links Corridor, including works across Torquay Terrace.

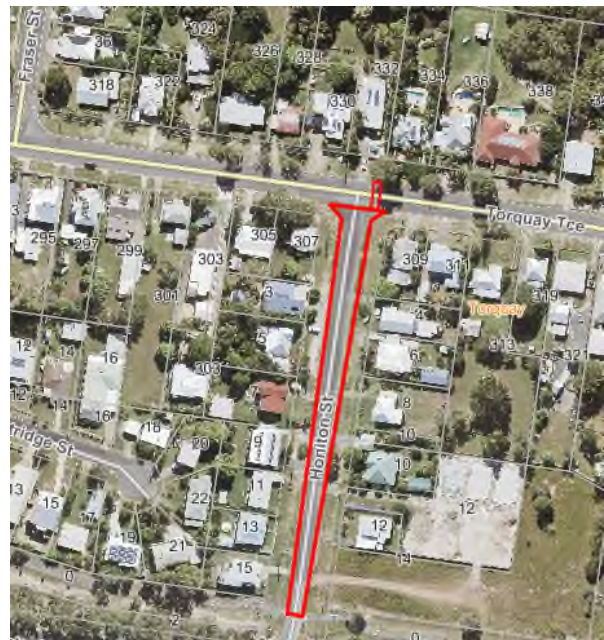
This project was identified for completion as part of Council's road reconstruction prioritisation process.

#### PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$540,000

#### PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Pavement rehabilitation works including new asphalt surfacing;
- New kerb and channel;
- Driveway crossover construction with tie in to existing driveways using same material as existing driveways (plain concrete or gravel);
- Replacement of existing drainage system with underground stormwater network;
- Subsoil drainage works;
- Pavement marking;
- Restoration works.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.

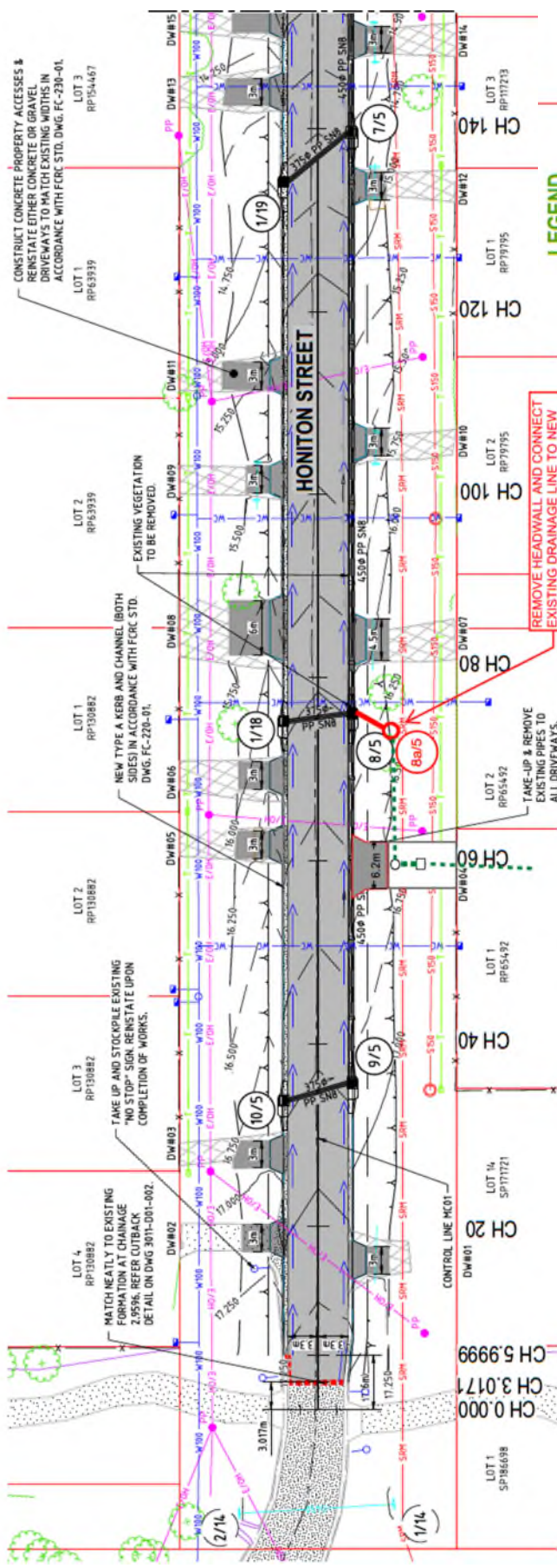
