

Footpath Construction—Frangipanni Avenue and Eugenia Way (Grevillea Street to Oleander Avenue)

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a 1.3m wide concrete footpath on the southern side of Frangipanni Avenue and on the western side of Eugenia Way between Grevillea Street and Oleander Avenue. Works also include the installation of a refuge island crossing point adjacent to 25 Frangipanni Avenue.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's Active Travel Strategy.



PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$205,000 (this project is partly funded through the State Government's Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Concrete footpath construction;
- Removal and replacement of a section of driveway from properties located at 5, 9, 11, 17, 19 and 30
 Frangipanni Avenue and 3 and 5 Eugenia Way. (reinstatement works to be completed in plain concrete only);
- Precast safety islands x 2 and kerb ramps to access the crossing point including signage;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.

The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.




