# Footpath Replacement—Kent Street

## (between Ferry Street and Railway Line)

#### **PROJECT:**

This project provides for the replacement of the existing concrete footpath on the northern side of Kent Street between Ferry Street and the Railway line with a 1.8m-3m wide concrete footpath.

This footpath project was identified for replacement as part of Council's annual footpath inspection programme.

### **PROJECT ESTIMATE:**

\$260,000 (This project will be delivered with funding from the Queensland Government's Works for Queensland Funding Program)

#### **PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:**

The Project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Construction of a new 1.8m-3m wide concrete footpath on the northern side of Kent Street between Ferry Street and the railway line;
- The reconstruction of the existing driveway adjacent to the Maryborough Central State School including kerb and channel in this location to march existing kerb and channel;
- The reconstruction of a section of kerb and channel at the corner of Kent Street and John Street;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
