Hi folks,

A check on our records shows that the environmentally relevant activity conducted at the above premises falls within the category of "Timber milling and woodchipping- (47) where milling is defined as **milling** includes sawing, cutting, chipping, compressing, dressing, finger-jointing, and machining.

Information submitted by Dale and Myers in 2007 (with an application for a registration certificate) indicates that quantities processed are 350 cu m per week.

Assuming a minimum density of 350 kg/cu m - this would equate to 122 tonne per week- which would require 42 weeks operation to exceed the threshold for environmentally relevant activity 47.

Council intends to advise the operators of this facility that, based on the information contained in their application of 2007 and sec 153 of the epr, the environmentally relevant activity is likely to fall within the category of environmentally relevant activity 47 and that the current rego cert for environmentally relevant activity 68 "wooden product manufacture" is no longer applicable.

Could you please advise if you would like any further advice on this activity.

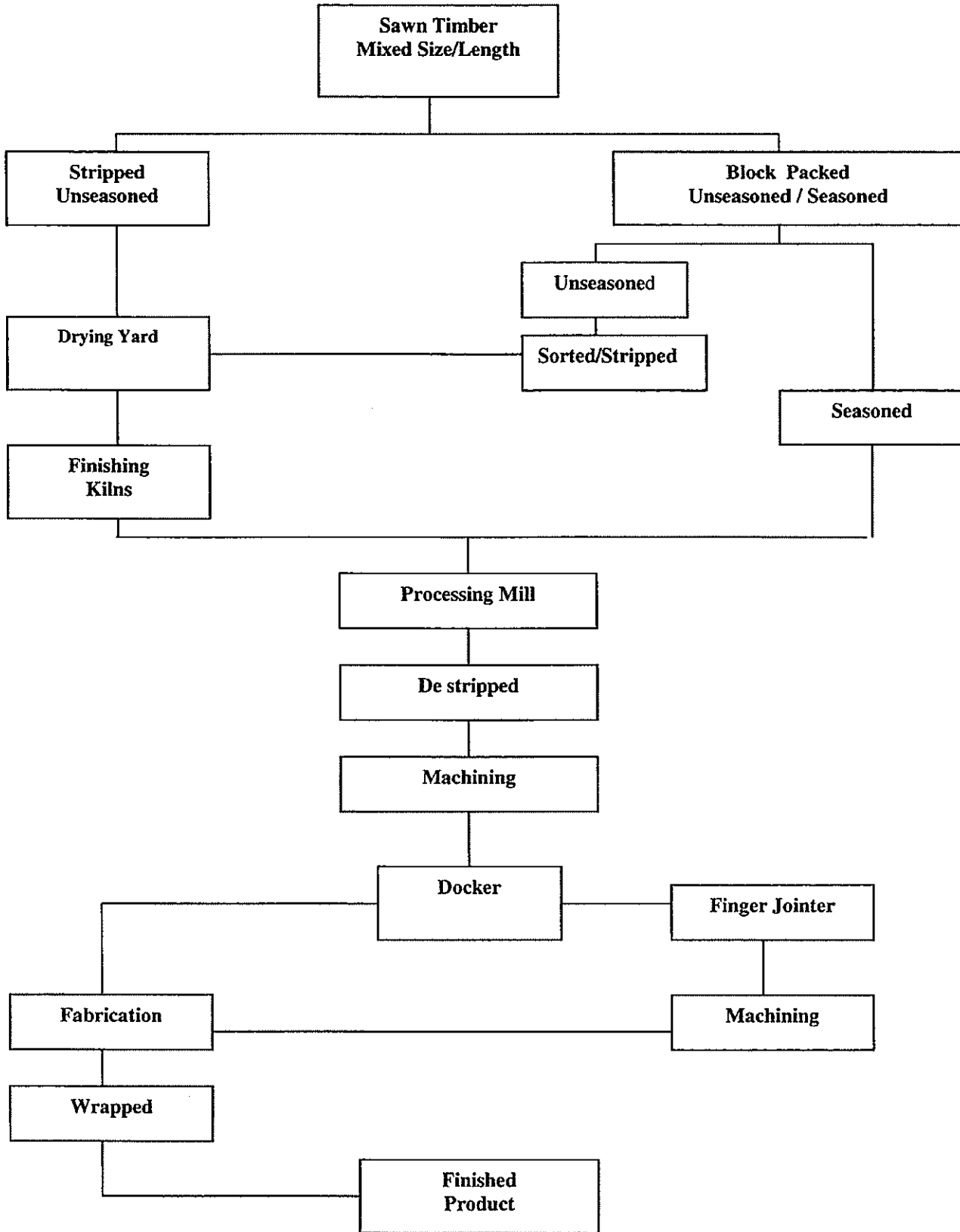

I refer to the compliance inspection of Baywood Products Pty Ltd conducted at 267 Kinghorn Road, Granville on 21 July 2015 by authorised persons Denise Batten and Carol Hardy of the Department of Environment and Heritage Protection as well as Andrew McDonald of Fraser Coast Regional Council. The site inspection was conducted in the presence of yourself and Mr Johathan Pedersen, Director of Baywood Products Pty Ltd.

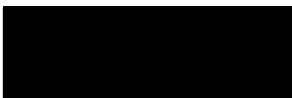
