

Timber Bridge Replacement—North Aramara Road

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of the timber bridge located on North Aramara Road approximately 35m north of the Maryborough Biggenden Road intersection.

The bridge replacement works are being undertaken as the result of a bridge inspection program that identified that the existing bridge required replacement as it had reached the end of its useful life.

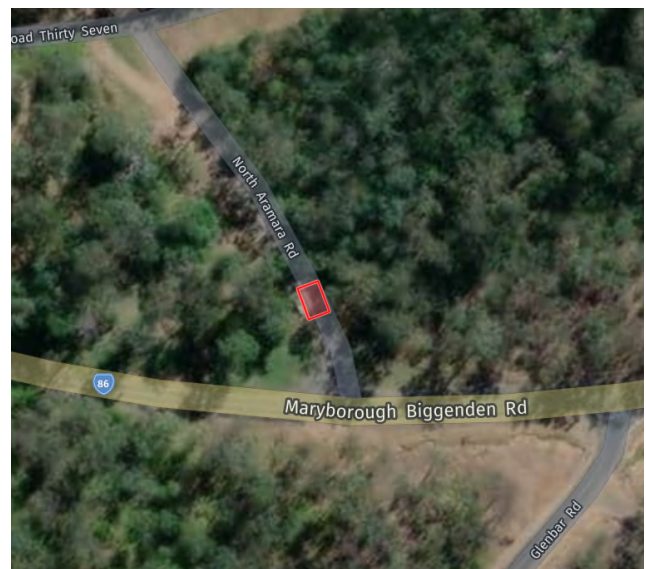
PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1.5M (This project will be delivered with funding of \$1.32M from the Queensland Government’s Works for Queensland Funding Program with remaining funds from Council’s Capital Budget)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The Project scope is as follows:

- Construction of side track;
- Demolition/Disposal of existing bridge;
- Earthworks & removal of trees;
- Supply and construction of precast concrete bridge and associated roadworks;
- Rock protection;
- Signage, topsoil and restoration of disturbed areas.



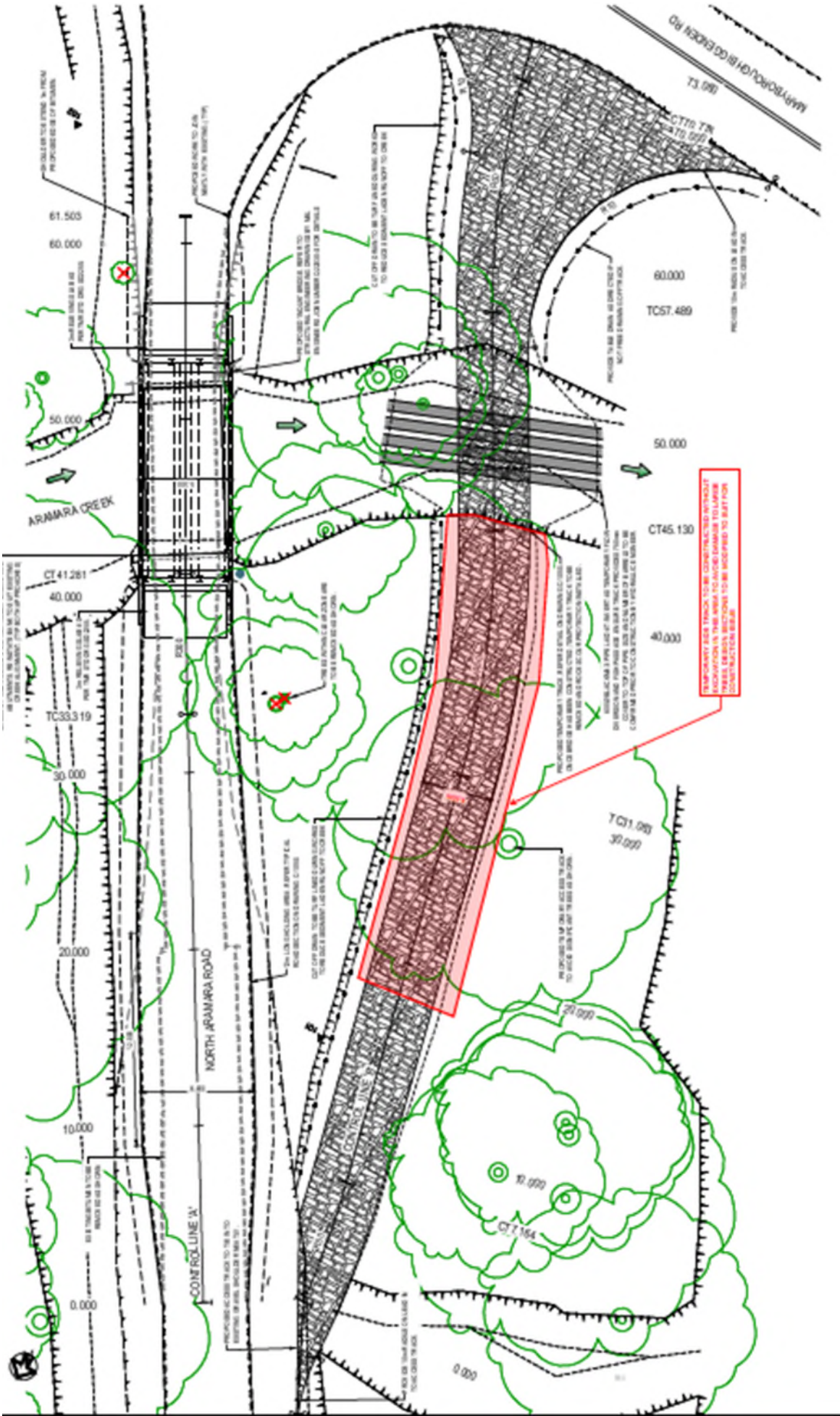
The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
