

Sectional Kerb and Channel Replacement – Tulipwood Drive (Walworth St to Figtree Way)

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of approximately 65m of existing kerb and channel on the northern side of Tulipwood Drive, between Walworth Street and Figtree Way.

The works are being undertaken as a result of inspections carried out as part of Council’s ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the kerb and channel was showing signs of failure and distress.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$98,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Replacement of approximately 65m of existing kerb and channel on the northern side of Tulipwood Drive from Walworth Street towards Figtree Way;
- Pavement reconstruction at a width of approximately 2m from the kerb along the length of the project, including replacement of the pavers in this excavation area;
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic and pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will allow for the works to be completed under a traffic control arrangement with a traffic controller in place to control the traffic entry and exit at this location.
