

Nissen Street and Islander Road Intersection Signalisation

PROJECT:

This project provides for the installation of traffic signals at the corner of Nissen Street and Islander Road, Hervey Bay.

The completion of this project will provide for improvements to traffic performance as well as pedestrian safety during peak periods.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1.6M (this project is partly funded by the Australian Government's Black Spot Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Installation of traffic signals at the Nissen Street and Islander Road intersection;
- Widening of Nissen Street in front of commercial properties located at 12 Nissen Street and Storage King to allow for 10 line marked on-street carparking spaces;
- Construction of a concrete indented carparking bay to allow for 2 carparks in Islander Road;
- New areas of concrete footpath at each intersection leg;
- New kerb ramps;
- New kerb and channel;
- Road surfacing;
- Turning lanes;
- New pavement marking including areas of no stopping lines (yellow line marking on each intersection leg);
- Topdressing and turfing of disturbed areas.



The traffic and pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing.
