

Glenbar Road Culvert Replacement

PROJECT:

This project provides for the replacement of the existing corrugated steel pipe culvert located on Glenbar Road (500m south of the Thinoomba Road intersection) with reinforced concrete stormwater pipes and associated headwalls.

These works are being undertaken as a result of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified that the existing steel pipe culvert was showing signs of failure and distress.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$760,000

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Construction and subsequent removal of access tracks;
- Installation of reinforced concrete pipes under Glenbar Road with progressive removal of the existing corrugated steel pipe (cut and cover);
- Construction of new reinforced concrete headwalls, wingwalls and aprons;
- Reshaping of the inlet to suit the new apron and wingwalls and construction of dumped rock for outlet scour protection;
- Reinstatement works.



The traffic management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing however, the contractor is proposing the construction of a side track to ensure that no road closures are required whilst the culvert replacement works are completed.
