

Urangan Pier Rehabilitation

PROJECT:

This project provides for the rehabilitation of the Urangan Pier superstructure in four separate locations.

This project was identified for completion as part of Council's ongoing asset inspection program which identified various areas of deterioration.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$1M (this project is funded through the State Government's Works for Queensland Funding Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Site establishment and installation of security fencing.
- Temporary disconnection and reconnection of lighting, electrical, mains water and cathodic protection system as required.
- Supply and installation of new timber superstructure from Bent No. 174 to Bent No. 188.
- Inspect, assess and maintain/repair/replace girders, corbels and associated hardware if required.
- Remove and replace decking boards, kerb and associated connection bolts and brackets.
- Commissioning and reopening of structure to public.



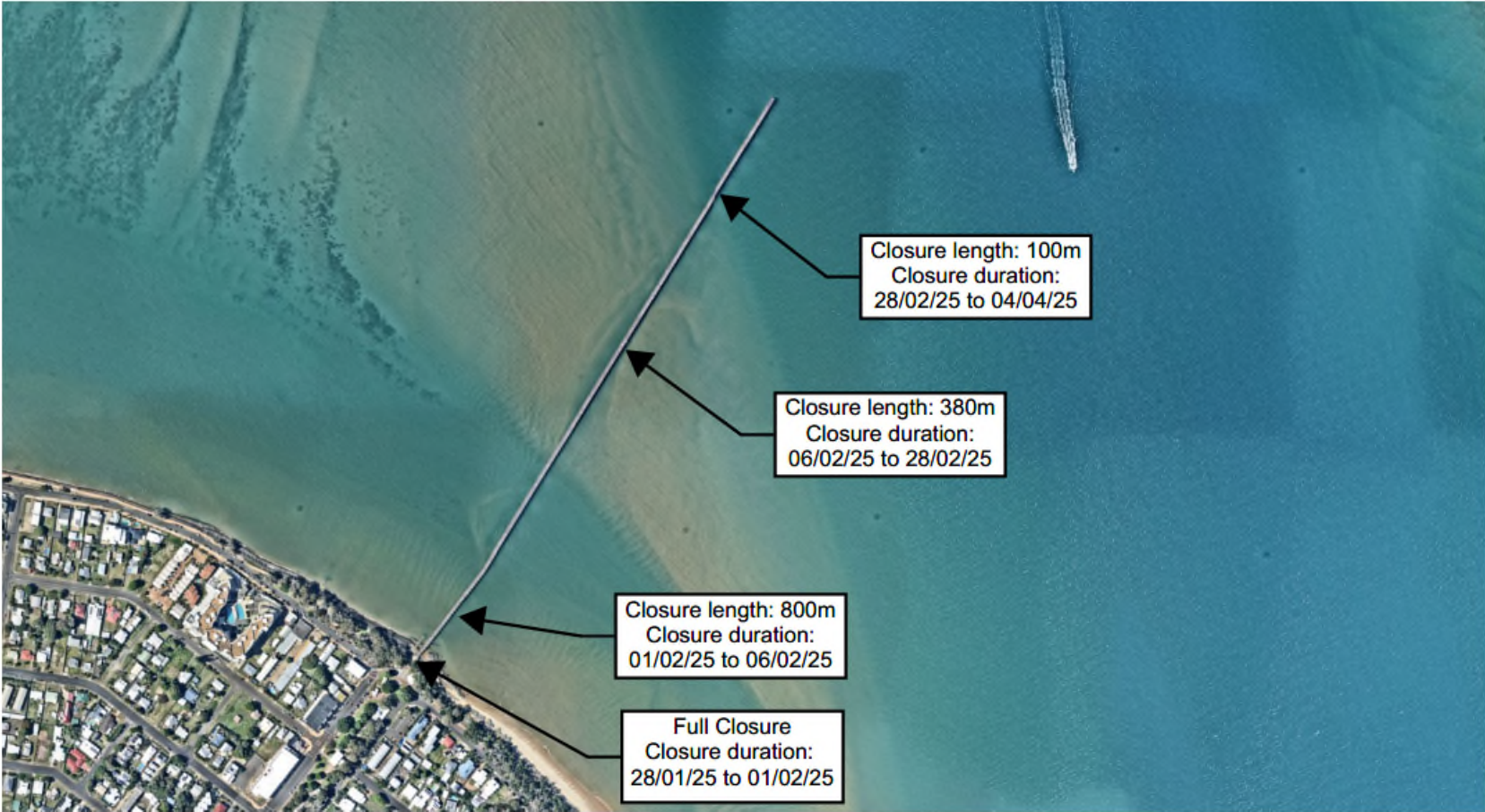
The pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the project will require the closure of various sections of the Urangan Pier whilst the works are being completed.
