

Urangan Revetment Wall

PROJECT:

This project provides for the construction of a revetment wall on the Hervey Bay foreshore between the Urangan Pier to a position approximately 150 metres east of the Pier.

The completion of this project will provide protection to public infrastructure from coastal erosion.

PROJECT ESTIMATE:

\$3.2M (this project is partly funded by the Australian Government's Coastal and Estuarine Risk Mitigation Program)

PROJECT SCOPE OF WORKS:

The project scope is as follows:

- Excavation and earthworks;
- Construction of rock seawall and beach access staircase;
- Landscaping, including areas of revegetation and associated works.

The pedestrian management plan that will be put in place for the duration of the construction period will be developed prior to works commencing; however, a site plan detailing the alternative beach access points, exclusion zones and the location of the Contractor's compound that will be implemented during the construction of the seawall is attached for information purposes.



It should be noted that as part of the completion of this project, from late October 2024 to late March 2025 the Contractor will be utilising sections of Boat Harbour Drive, Pulgul Street, Kent Street, Larsen Street, Guard Street and Charlton Esplanade as their haul route for the transportation of materials during the construction of the seawall. A plan detailing the designated haulage route is also attached for information purposes.




